

Third Grade

In Computer Literacy third graders begin their journey into the study of information and media literacy via use of computers and the Internet. Four primary areas are covered: introduction to basic navigational skills; introduction to touch-typing; introduction to word processing; and introduction to multimedia via two curriculum integration projects (Multimedia books/Stories, Poetry Project, Haudenoshonee Project or Digital Yearbook).

Fourth Grade

In Computer Literacy fourth graders deepen their journey into the study of information and media literacy via use of computers and the Internet. The four primary areas are broadened: reinforcement and expansion of basic navigational skills; reinforcement and expansion of touch-typing/keyboarding skills; expansion of word processing skills; and expansion and deepening of multimedia literacy and skills via two curriculum integration projects (River Study, Poetry Project, Readers' Recommendations or Digital Yearbook). Fourth graders also explore an introduction to research on the Internet and an introduction to communications programs in preparation for Middle School.
